In November 2019 a member's gathering was held at the offices of B&E Together in South Yorkshire. Members were invited to attend the event to share practise around Work Experience (WEX), to network, listen to updates from the AEBP and discuss what they would like to see next from the AEBP. In addition, a brief training session was given on how members can access and update their own pages of the member directory on the website.

- How to raise funds

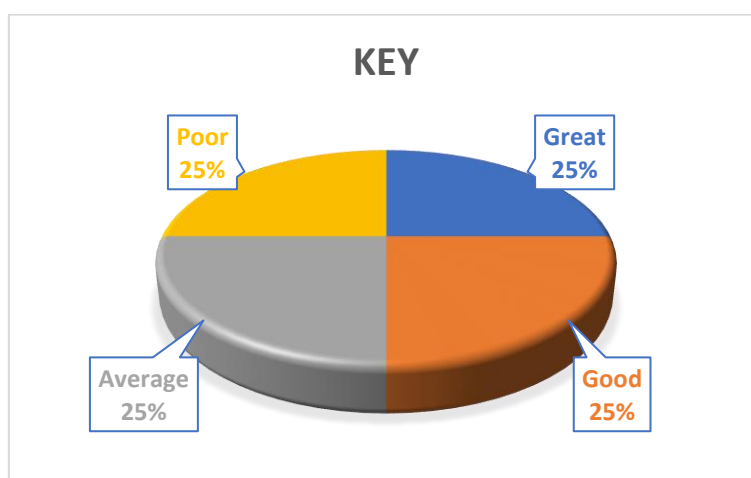
Suggestions for the future direction of the AEBP included:

- Cost analysis of different programmes / models of WEX

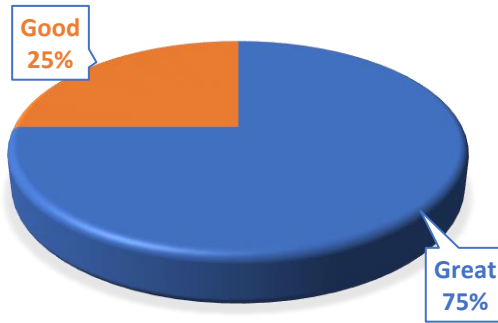
The day was broken down into nine sessions including lunch as follows

- Website Update – Kevin Donnelly, BE Foundation

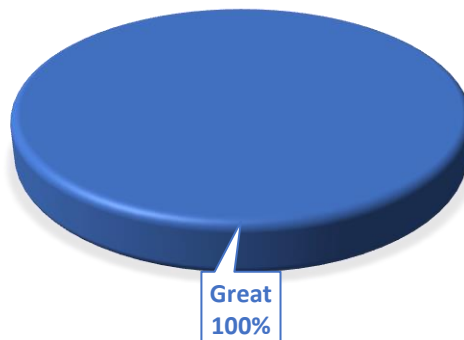
Attendees were asked to rate the individual sessions from one of four categories. Data has been analysed and graphed on the following pages using the below key.



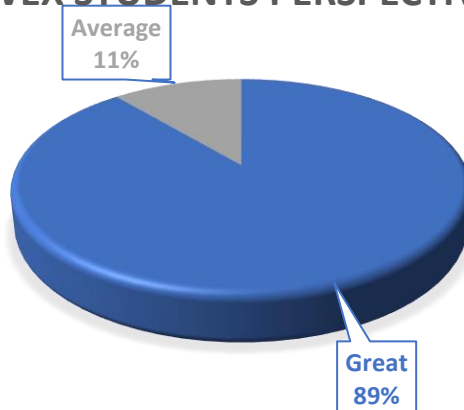

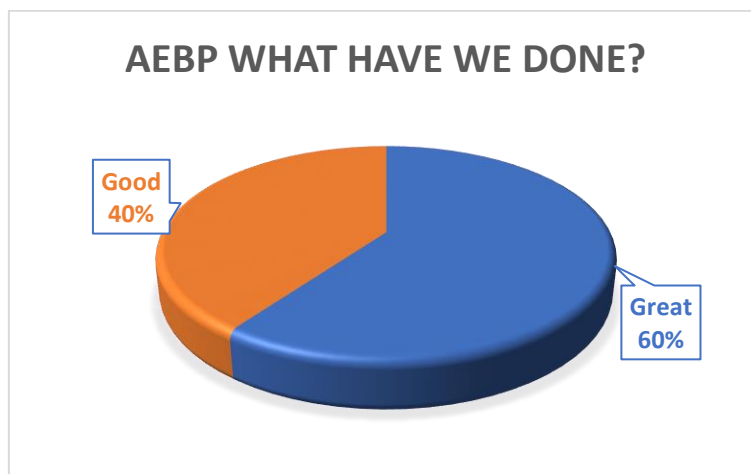
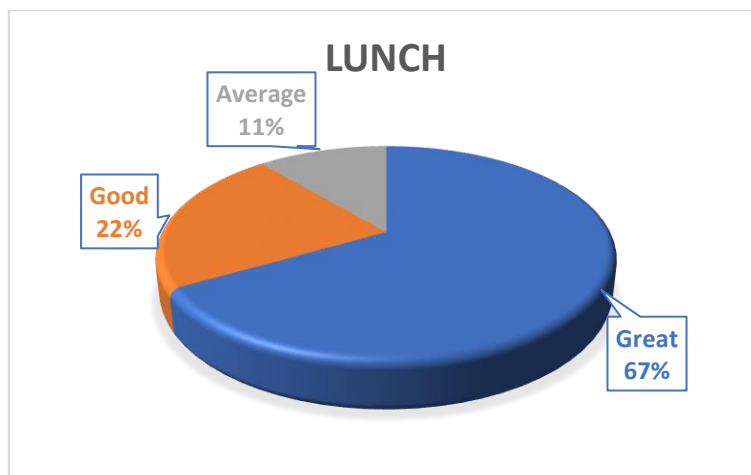
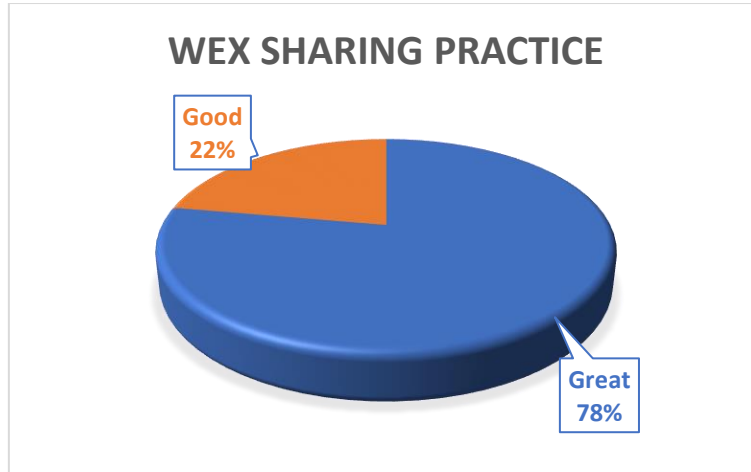


### WEX SCHOOLS PERSPECTIVE

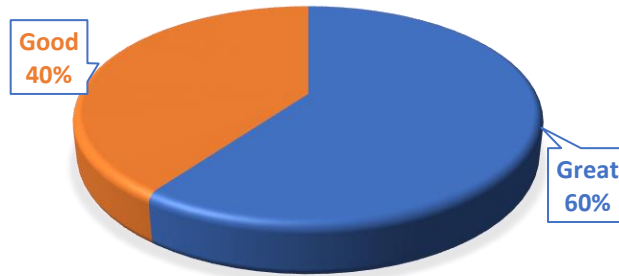
